Technical Assistance Q&A

Q: Is a Housing Authority, which is designated as a municipal corporation and receives federal and state funds, eligible to apply for Title IIIB funding? Since federal funds cannot be used for the 15% match, what funds can a Housing Authority use for the match?

A: Yes, Housing Authorities are eligible to apply for Title IIIB funding. State, local, private or any other non-federal funds may be used for the 15% match.

Q: Do you know how many applicants to expect who are focusing on the “outreach programs for elders with limited English proficiency” project area?

A: This is the first year that Springwell is requesting proposals for outreach programs for elders with limited English proficiency, so we do not know how many proposals to expect.

Q: Can applicants cite salary as their primary budget item for the project?

A: If the salary is for the staff directly responsible for the grant-funded project, then yes, applicants may have that salary as one of the primary items for the project budget.

Q: Can faith communities who serve elders with limited English proficiency apply for funding?

A: Yes, faith communities are welcome to apply for funding.

Q: If a faith community submitted a proposal to offer a community meal site that serves a particular cultural and linguistic need, would this be eligible for funding?

A: All proposals submitted to Springwell will be evaluated for funding based on the criteria outlined in the RFP.
